their directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, officials, volunteers, business operators, and site property owners, (all of them collectively called the HOST).

I am aware and understand that there are Inherent DANGERS, HAZARDS, and RISKS, (collectively called RISKS) associated with Equine Activities. I Acknowledge that these Inherent "RISKS" of Equine Activities mean those DANGEROUS conditions which are an integral part of Equine Activities, including but not limited to:

- 1) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity;
- 2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- 3) the equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects;
- 4) collisions with other equines, animals, people, and objects;
- 5) the potential of any participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability. I understand that injuries resulting from such "RISKS" are a common and ordinary occurrence associated with Equine Activities. I freely accept and fully assume all the "RISKS" and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss from being a Participant. I Acknowledge that it remains my sole responsibility to act in such a manner as to be responsible for my own safety and to Participate within my own limits. In consideration of the "HOST" permitting my Participation in the "ACTIVITY", I together with my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, (collectively called my "Legal Representatives") agree as follows:

- 1) To Waive All Claims that I may have against the "HOST"; and,
- 2) To Release the "HOST" from Any and All Liability for any loss, damages, injury, or expense that I or my "Legal Representatives" may suffer as a result of my Participation in the "ACTIVITY" due to any cause whatsoever INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE "HOST"; and,
- 3) TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the "HOST" from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my Participation in the "ACTIVITY".

I have read and understand the Rules of the "Activity" which apply to me. I agree to abide by those Rules and Acknowledge that a breach of the Rules may among other things result in my expulsion from the "ACTIVITY". PRESIDENT

- a) *Chair meetings once a month.*
- b) *Publish agenda for meetings.*
- c) *Assist executive members with duties as required.*
- d) *Oversee Grounds maintenance.*

VICE PRESIDENT

- a) *Chair meetings in the President's absence, and assist the President as required.*
- b) *Assist Education Committee re clinics, camps, seminars, lectures etc.*
- c) *Take club bookings.*

TREASURER

- a) *Maintain and execute A/P and A/R Files*
- b) *Maintain books (Ledger, cheque, deposit)*
- c) *Provide Reports to Executive Members at meetings (Transactions, cash flow, net worth).*
- d) *Provide Annual Budget at AGM.*

SECRETARY

- a) *Take Minutes at Executive and General Meetings.*

- c) *Maintain up to date alphabetical Membership Form File.*
- d) *Maintain and Publish up to date Membership List and provide copies to Executive, Clubhouse, Committee Members.*
- e) *Maintain and distribute Membership Tags.*

VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE (2 people)

- a) *Arrange for a work party list to be published.*
- b) *Supervise and/or assist at work parties.*
- c) *Arrange for a Volunteer Form to be published and/or distributed.*
- d) *Collect Signed Volunteer Forms.*
- e) *Monitor Membership Volunteer hours.*

SHOW COMMITTEES (5 people per show – TOTAL OF 20)

- a) *Arrange Spring H/J Show*
- b) *Arrange Spring Dressage Show*
- c) *Arrange Fall H/J Show*
- d) *Arrange Fall Dressage Show*

EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE (2 people)

- a) *Arrange for jumps and dressage equipment to be handled and stored properly.*
- b) *Arrange for equipment to be repaired and painted as required.*
- c) *Prepare a typed inventory of equipment*
- d) *Arrange for new jumps to be built as required.*

WEBSITE COORDINATOR (1 person)

- a) *Gather information to be posted on website.*
- b) *Work in conjunction with the website designer to ensure the website is current.*
- c) *Maintain website.*

ADVERTISING COMMITTEE (3 people)

- a) *Assist with sponsorship when required.*
- b) *Place Show Schedules in horse magazines.*
- c) *Provide newspapers, TV, HCBC with information on shows, events etc that are being held at the club.*

SOCIAL COMMITTEE (3 people)

- a) *Arrange for refreshments for AGM and work parties.*
- b) *At Executive's direction, arrange a fundraiser (eg. Silent Auction)*
- c) *At Executive's direction, arrange special socials (eg. Wine and Cheese)*
- d) *Maintain and inventory clubhouse items.*

GROUNDS AND STABLES COMMITTEE (5 people)

- a) *Arrange for tractor repair and maintenance.*
- b) *Arrange for ring maintenance. (harrowing, irrigation, etc.)*
- c) *Arrange for Irrigation Company to perform spring start up and fall blow out and make repairs as required.*
- d) *Arrange for fence repair and painting.*
- e) *Arrange for septic system control*
- f) *Arrange shavings delivery and manure removal.*
- g) *Arrange for stables to be kept clean and in good repair and painted.*
- h) *Arrange Work Parties.*
- i) *Arrange for grass cutting contract, to be performed in a proper and timely manner.*
- j) *Arrange for and supervise casual labour to perform necessary jobs and repairs and ensure proper invoices are submitted to treasurer.*

HI-POINT COORDINATOR (1 person)

- a) *Copy and distribute Hi-Point forms to various barns.*
- b) *Gather information for Hi-Point awards.*
- c) *Purchase awards (within a predetermined budget given by the executive) to be presented at the AGM.*

GAMING/LOTTERY COORDINATOR (2 people)
